Obsequies and Celebration of Life THE GLORIOUS CHRONICLE OF AN ESTEEMED DENOMINATIONAL DOYEN AND JURISDICTIONAL PROLOCUTOR

The esteemed Bishop Sedgwick Daniels, a remarkable individual who left an enduring legacy as a beacon of light in the realms of education, humanitarianism, and ecclesiastical leadership. Auscultating the unfolding of God's divine beneficence, Bishop Daniels' profound impact will forever be etched in the annals of history.

The Embarkation

Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee; and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, and I ordained thee a prophet unto the nations. Jeremiah 1:5

An angelic aperture of the heavens made way for the birth of Sedgwick Daniels, née to the late John and Supervisor Kathryn Daniels, on August 16, 1959. At this precise moment in time, God crafted with focused intention and divine will, a perfectly aligned predestination. A cosmic assignment mandated before the formation of the world. God specifically decided to mold as clay- a leader that would be uncommon amongst uncommon men as a harbinger of hope, a luminary of wisdom, a pioneer of spiritual administration and a model of pastoral austerity.

The Extraction

Bishop Daniels was called out from the common, into a life of extraordinary service and duty. Cut from the sacred cloth of Christ, God carefully bespoke Bishop Daniels as a leader; gracefully constructing him to be a man of dignity, sterling character and a shepherd for his people, touching the lives of thousands for over half a century. His noble disposition, peerless inquisitiveness, and distinctive wisdom established a stark delineation—as a young man who stood out among his peers. Raised in a household of faith, inevitably purposed to influence countless households of faith, Bishop's saxicolous upbringing with undeniable positioning on the bedrock of holiness shaped a life that was succinctly designed for godly learning, living and leading. With an insatiable longing to find a deeper personal understanding of the Lord, he found himself immersed in a cocoon of sacred anointing—a transcendental journey that launched him into unchartered dimensions and to walk uprightly in the excogitation of the Lord. Embracing his biblical foundation, pursuing spiritual excellence and maintaining a religious sagacity that incorporated fervent Baptist traditions with a newly discovered Pentecostal experience. This exclusive fusion of traditional understanding and modern perspective created a venerable foundation which allowed him to become a celebrated and transformative potentate.

The Emergence

From the captivating city of Milwaukee, Wisconsin, Bishop Daniels graced the world as the celebrated establishmentarian and senior pastor of the Holy Redeemer Institutional Church Of God In Christ. He was revered as a true rotavator in the vineyards of the Kingdom, planting boldly and watering bountifully for the glorious harvest for the Lord. The penetratingly studious nature that he possessed inspired him to pursue the biblical principle of 'seeking to understand'. This search led him to the discoveries of understanding the true needs of people for whom he was called to inspire which resulted in architecting innovative bespoke approaches that led to sustainable change. His transformative influence extended far beyond the boundaries of a single congregation, reaching communities across Wisconsin, Eastern Minnesota, Western Michigan, and Northern Illinois which yet expanded globally in countries beyond the United States.

The impeccable and stellar Pentecostal witness of Elder Daniels created a glowingly harmonious atmosphere and an ambience of holiness for those entrusted to his stewardship. His intriguing causeries empowered the saints to serve God, treasure family and work diligently to provide holistic familial service. Bishop Daniels' commitment to community empowerment was embodied by the vision known as the Bishop's Creek. This remarkable initiative transformed the Holy Redeemer complex into a beacon of hope and progress. The Bishop's Creek community development corporation, founded in 2006, revitalized the neighborhood surrounding Holy Redeemer's sacred abode on the north side of Milwaukee. Numerous institutions, including senior housing, a children's orphanage, homes for family reunification, and facilities for youth, stand as testaments to Bishop Daniels' unwavering commitment to uplifting the community.

Educational empowerment held a special place in Bishop Daniels' heart. Within the Holy Redeemer complex, the Holy Redeemer Educational Consortium stood as a pillar of knowledge and enlightenment. From early childhood to higher education, these institutions continue to shape the minds and hearts of generations to come.

The Ennoblement

Elevated to the esteemed role of Church of God in Christ Jurisdictional Prelate in 2001, Bishop Daniels continued on his remarkable ministerial journey that spanned over four decades. He created a litany of initiatives designed to provide spiritual enlightenment, economic prosperity, educational empowerment, and societal transformation all of which became the hallmarks of his leadership. While he was an adamant opposer of cynosure, his focus kept him dutifully bound to offer selfless investment and guidance to the Wisconsin First Ecclesiastical Jurisdiction, which flourished while witnessing an exponential growth to over 100 inspired churches and ministries across the region.

Bishop Daniels' impact reverberated on a global scale as a General Board Member of the Church Of God In Christ. Elected and consecrated in 2008, he adorned this prestigious role with grace and distinction, earning re-election in four subsequent quadrennial elections. His unwavering dedication and support as Secretary to the General Board during the pivotal 2016 Quadrennial showcased his invaluable contributions to COGIC leadership. Moreover, during the tumultuous period of the COVID-19 pandemic, Bishop Daniels selflessly embraced the interim role of 2nd Assistant Presiding Bishop, exemplifying his unwavering commitment to spiritual and organizational leadership.

The Expansion

Bishop Daniels had a strong educational background that fueled the founding of The Holy Redeemer Educational Consortium. HREC is located at the complex and includes the Holy Redeemer Fine Arts Possentum, Holy Redeemer Christian Academy for K-8 students, Young-Coggs University Preparatory Academy for middle and high school students, Hudson-Herron Ministers Institute, and a partnership with Marian University of Fond du Lac, offering accredited undergraduate and graduate degrees onsite at HR. The Institute for the Preservation of African American Music and Arts (I-PAMA) was founded in 2016, coinciding with the 30th anniversary of the Holy Redeemer congregation. Since its inception, I-PAMA has opened two campuses on the north side of Milwaukee. The William J. Tucker East Campus is on site at the Holy Redeemer Campus and the Martel C. Scott West Campus is housed at a former research center designed by Frank Lloyd Wright.

Through his diverse and holistic approach to ministry, thousands have been positively impacted, breaking down cultural, financial, and familial barriers. His collaborative and transparent approach has been crucial in strengthening the global outreach of the largest African American Pentecostal church in the world. Admired for his humility and personal sacrifice, Bishop Daniels was inspired by Daniel 10:7 to expand the vision God has given him and firmly lived by his motivational modus operandi that "There is nothing too hard for God."

The Erudition

God gave them knowledge and skill in all learning and wisdom: and Daniel had understanding in all visions and dreams. Daniel 1:17

The insatiable appetite for education, acute affinity for scholarship and his sagacious persistence activated his mission to pursue education for self and others. Bursting with an array of academic prowess, He stood poised and ready to serve! Anchored by a rich educational tapestry, which includes a Bachelor of Arts in Business Administration, a Master's degree in Interdisciplinary Studies and Organizational Leadership, and a shining Doctorate in Ministry, his intellectual arsenal was indeed vast. In addition to his academic achievements, he held numerous certifications, licenses, and honorary degrees. These collective academic achievements resoundingly confirmed his thought leadership and cerebral value which further bolstered his impact on the Kingdom both near and abroad.

Learning Beyond his religious and community work, Bishop Daniels was called upon to bring kingdom minded leadership to governance, serving on the boards of over 15 prestigious organizations, merging his business activities with ecumenical stewardship. His leadership philosophy of equanimity infused decision making, was shaped by his Alabama Baptist and Wisconsin Pentecostal sagacity, nurtured by his parents and grandparents.

The Emancipation

In a divine tableau orchestrated by the Immaculately Almighty God, the sacred journey of his mortal soul, which commenced on the auspicious day of August 16th, 1959, continued toward its heavenly destination. As the celestial clock chimed, at the precise hour of 5:24 pm Central Standard Time, the mortal shall transcend the boundaries of mortality, embracing the realm of the immortal.

As we bid farewell to this extraordinary luminary, let us remember Bishop Sedgwick Daniels for his unwavering commitment to education, humanitarianism, and ecclesiastical leadership.
